Leadership Committee Member Expectations

FORTE Leadership Committee members may serve three two-year terms (September to August), not including any terms of vice chair or chair.

- Serves as an active member of an ISO committee and/or as a chair/co-chair of a FORTE subcommittee. Engage FORTE members as sub-committee members, as needed.
- Is a FORTE member and recruits at least 10 new FORTE members annually.
- Makes a personal or company financial contribution to the ISO's Annual Fund of \$750 annually.
- Pay FORTE membership fee to the ISO of \$39 annually.
- Regularly attends and actively participates in Leadership Committee meetings.
- Supports the ISO and FORTE through regular attendance (at least 75%) at Happy Hour concerts, networking events, and other FORTE-sponsored special events and programs.
