# ISO Announces Classical Series at the Palladium for 2017-2018

ISO Music Director Krzysztof Urbański to conduct three performances; guest artists include prolific pianist Emanuel Ax and rising international conducting star Karina Canellakis.

Due to popular demand, the ISO will have **two** performances of Handel's Messiah at the Palladium.

*April 3, 2017*— The Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra returns to Carmel in the 2017–18 Season for the Telamon *Classical Series at the Palladium*. Six classical concerts will be performed at the Palladium at the Center for the Performing Arts in the coming season. Subscriptions are on sale now; sales of single tickets begin August 7.

ISO Music Director Krzysztof Urbański is set to conduct three concerts in Carmel, beginning with a rare musical experience – a trio of Prokofiev Piano Concertos featuring pianists Anna Vinnitskaya, Garrick Ohlsson, and Alon Goldstein on November 19. Urbański brings Beethoven to the Palladium on March 11 as Yefim Bronfman plays the composer's Third Piano Concerto. The ISO's intensive study of Mozart's final year includes a performance of his *Requiem* on June 3 with the incomparable pianist Emanuel Ax and the Indianapolis Symphonic Choir.

Three additional classical concerts bring a diverse repertoire to the Palladium. Fans of the American masters will enjoy an afternoon of Bernstein and Copland on October 15 under the direction of Florida Orchestra Music Director Michael Francis. Back by popular demand, two performances of Handel's majestic *Messiah* bring the ISO and the Indianapolis Symphonic Choir together in December, and rising star Karina Canellakis leads the ISO for Rachmaninoff's triumphant Second Symphony on May 6.
