Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra to perform during National Eucharistic Conference in Indianapolis

The ISO will perform an original score on Sunday, July 21, at Lucas Oil Stadium

INDIANAPOLIS—The Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra will be part of the closing day ceremonies at the National Eucharistic Congress, which runs from July 17–21. The event will be held at Lucas Oil Stadium and the convention center.

The orchestra will perform an original score written by David and Lauren Moore titled the Mass of Peace along with other traditional liturgical music. The ISO is honored to be a part of this historic event, harkening back to nearly 400 years of tradition of orchestral masses.

More than 50,000 are expected to attend. The National Eucharistic Congress is the first of its kind in 83 years.
